"Talking Jesus" 2022 showed that people's openness to the gospel in the UK has dramatically increased in the UK since the Covid pandemic. We are looking forward to Rachel sharing on the research, and the impact for the UK Church and how we should mobilise in evangelism.

Pete Greig is the founder of the 24-7 Prayer movement. He is also the Senior Pastor of Emmaus Rd Church alongside his wife Sammy, a director of Waverley Abbey Trust, and a multi-award-winning author whose books have been translated into many languages. His other resources include The Prayer Course – downloaded more than three million times, the Lectio Course, and Lectio365 – a daily devotional used regularly by more than 220,000 people. Village Shop

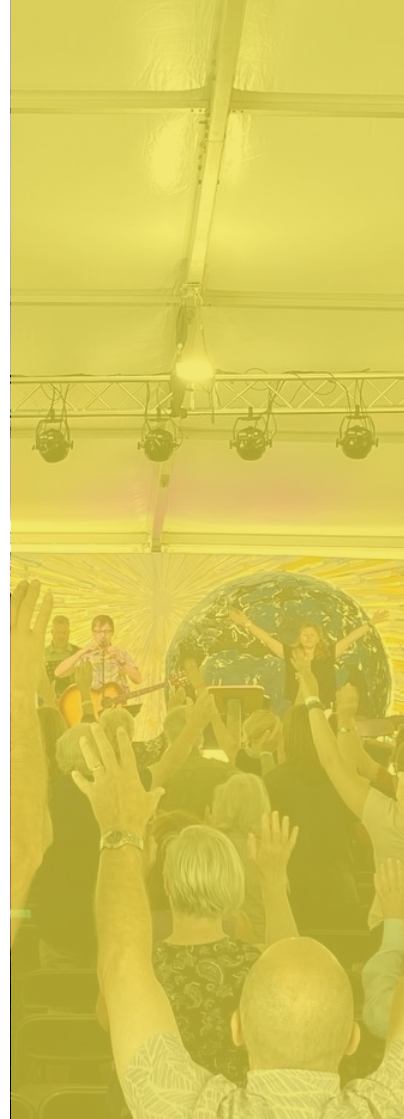
