

## Roles to help Run Revive

Name of Team	Role description	Skill requirements/ Personal characteristics
<b>Stewarding</b>	A varied role, stewarding involves anything from welcoming people into venues, giving directions or monitoring the car park. Your job is to make sure guests are cared for and is a great way to meet people and be a core part of the Revive experience.	This role is for over 18's only. You will need to have a good level of physical fitness as will be required to stand for extended periods (approx. 1-2 hrs). You will enjoy working as part of a team, have a servant heart and a cheerful, enthusiastic manner. You will need to be assertive and willing to give gentle direction to Revive guests.
<b>Café Ash</b>	Cafe Ash is an entertainment hub, and a great place for people to unwind and relax at the end of the day. The role involves preparation and serving of light refreshments, clearing tables, and generally being engaging and hospitable.	This role would suit someone with a friendly disposition and a willingness to help in whatever way is needed. Some catering experience or customer service experience would be beneficial.
<b>Shop</b>	The Revive Shop is a busy hub for everyone looking for tasty snacks, refreshing drinks or campers' everyday essentials. For many guests it is the perfect place to stock up on essentials for breakfast, lunch, and dinner meals. You'll have plenty of opportunities to serve the entire event with a friendly and satisfying shopping experience.	This role would suit someone with a friendly disposition. You will need to have a willingness to serve customers as well as being willing to handle stock and to remain calm when it gets busy. A good knowledge of basic maths will be beneficial!
<b>Site Team</b>	Revive couldn't go ahead without the hardworking, practically minded team that sets up and maintains the event. As well as working during the week, some team members come a few days early to help with setup or stay on at the end to pack down. Please note on your application if you are interested in doing this.	Applicants should be over 18. This role would suit someone who is physically fit and able to lift heavy objects. Carpentry, plumbing or electrical skills would be advantageous, but not essential.
<b>Technical Team</b>	Revive relies on a wide range of technical equipment, including sound systems, lighting, video, and computer projection. In addition to operating systems at Revive, your help would be needed setting up and clearing away the event.	This role would suit someone with an aptitude for technical equipment and a willingness to serve. We need people with experience and those who would like to learn and develop skills during the week.
<b>First Aid Team</b>	Revive offers First Aid on site 24hrs a day. To be eligible for this role an applicant must hold an in-date accredited First Aid Certificate (minimum is First Aid at Work).  Registered Medical Professionals (Doctor, Paramedic, Nurse) will be considered without First Aid qualifications if they are currently registered with a professional governing body and can evidence indemnity insurance.	This role requires sufficient mobility to be able to move around the Revive site to respond to routine First Aid calls and Emergencies at an appropriate pace on foot. Standing for more than 1 hour is typical. First Aiders are often on shift on their own and so must be able to triage any calls for assistance that overlap. Strong communication, confidence, decision-making, and the ability to appropriately deal with crowds is vital.
