Experience working with young children – this could be through helping with creche at church, working in a nursery setting or through personal experience.  This role would suit someone who is a team player and has a heart for young children, with a willingness to create an environment that is nurturing. You will need to be able to get up and down from the floor and be happy to be on your feet for a lot of the morning.  An Ichthus DBS will be required for this role. This is completed as part of the application process and is FREE.
Popcorn	Working with children aged 5-10 years. Leading and motivating a small group of children in games, devotional times & activities. Popcorn is a fun-packed, spiritually dynamic programme running each morning and evening.	Experience working with children between 5 &10 years old – this could be through kids work at church, as a teacher or personal experience.  This role would suit someone who is able to lead a small group and motivate/encourage children in their walk with Jesus. The role requires a positive attitude and a willingness to get involved.  An Ichthus DBS will be required for this role. This is completed as part of the application process and is FREE.
Jesus Generation	Working with young people aged 11-14 years. Leading and motivating a small group of young people in games, devotional times & activities. If you want to be involved in equipping the young people to make a big impact for Christ, then this is the team for you.	Experience working with young people between 11 &14 years old – this could be through working with young people at church, as a teacher or personal experience.  This role would suit someone who is able to lead a small group and motivate/encourage young people in their walk with Jesus. The role requires a positive attitude and a willingness to get involved.  An Ichthus DBS will be required for this role. This is completed as part of the application process and is FREE.
SAS	Working with young people aged 15-17 years. Leading and motivating a small group of young people in activities, devotionals & discussions. If you want to be involved in equipping young people to make a big impact for Christ, then this is the team for you.	This role would suit someone who is a team player, self-motivated and has experience of working with youth. You will need to be flexible, spiritually mature, reliable, and willing to go the extra mile.  An Ichthus DBS will be required for this role. This is completed as part of the application process and is FREE.
Positive	Working with young adults aged 18-24 years. Spending time getting to know the young adults that attend, engaging them in lifestyle and theological discussions. Supporting them in prayer.	This role would suit someone who is good at engaging young adults in discussion and facilitating conversation between a group. You need to be self-motivated, a team player and able to support and guide young adults in their spiritual journey with Jesus.
Café Smooth	Working with young people aged 11- 17 years between 10pm and midnight. Spending time with the young people, facilitating games, discussion, and fun hangout time.	This role would suit someone who doesn't mind unsocial hours and is able to support young people in social time. You need to be spiritually mature and able to come alongside young people in a natural way.
